Day 1

- With a pick up from your premises, depart in time to catch your chosen ferry
- 1200 Arrive in Dover and check in with Sea France
- 1300 Ferry sails to Calais
- 1530 Arrive in Calais and depart for Paris
- 1900 Approximate arrival time at the hotel
- Rest of the evening free

Day 2

- Depart for day excursion with possible visits to:-

Musee d'Orsay

A visit to the imaginative museum of Impressionist painters is a must for anyone interested in art and a surprising diversion for those just wanting to know more about Paris and French culture. The ambience that has been created in a former railway station is outstanding and well worth a visit that will enrich the Paris experience

Cite des Science

The museum offers visitors an enthralling insight into the latest implications of science and technology. There are around 20 exhibitions covering the usual science subjects, such as the universe, water and the earth, man and health, industry and communication. It includes interactive experiments on light games, how we learn, computers, images, sounds and mathematics.

Day 3

- 0800 Breakfast is served
- Depart for day excursion with possible visits to:-

Eiffel Tower

The trip up to the top of the tower takes place by panoramic lift. At the top signs specify the directions and distances of major cities around the world and indicate the major Parisian landmarks. On the upper platform visitors can take in the entire city. On the second floor the interior gallery has animated display windows showing the construction of the tower and the operation of its lifts whilst glass floor panels provide a view of the square below. On the first floor are a host of entertainment features and information about the history of the tower

The Louvre

Entry to one of the world's best known museums and the home of the Mona Lisa is free to school groups but it is necessary to register the date and time of your visit in advance

Boat Trip

One of the classic ways to see the sights of Paris is to take a cruise along the River Seine. We can book these in advance and find that a floodlit evening cruise is a relaxing and informative way to round off the day. Cruises take about 75 minutes and there are frequent departures.

Day 4

0800 Breakfast is served
Depart for day excursion with possible visits to:-

Pompidou Centre

The finest collection of modern art in Europe is to be found here in one of the most controversial buildings of the twentieth century. Entry is free for those under 18 but a reservation must be made. Guides are available for various themes during your visit

Musee de l'air et de l'espace

Based in the original Paris airport of Le Bourget this museum presents the history of aviation in the original terminal buildings. There is a 12 minute 3D film that is taken from the flight deck on a test flight. Out on the tarmac you can climb aboard the prototype Concorde and visit various small planes as well as a 747 and there are also models of Ariane 1 and 5 rockets.

Day 5

0800 Breakfast is served
0930 Depart for Calais
1300 Arrive Calais and check in
1400 Ferry sails
1430 Arrive Dover and travel home
